Condemning the Terror Attack in France

29th October 2020

I as the Founder Chairman of World Humanitarian Drive (WHD) strongly condemn in strongest possible terms, the savage, cowardly, vile, barbaric, brutal and shameful knife attack in a place of worship in the city of Nice, France in which three innocent persons, including a woman lost their lives.
