He says the day will certainly pave way for creation of moral ecosystem, and values will be inculcated among the global community which has tasted the stark reality of the fragility of human existence during the pandemic coronavirus.

According to him, the COVID-19 days have shown a mirror to the world that everything is highly fragile and temporary, and only human values and morality can steer the world of the current crisis or any such crisis in the future too.

According to him, morality is the differentiation of decisions, actions, and intentions between the ones that are right or good, and the ones that are wrong or bad. Morality is also defined as conformity to the right conduct rules. Morality means rightness or goodness.

"The fabric of any society is held together by the standards of morality that we maintain and practice. Morals are our personal set of beliefs about what is important, unimportant, right, wrong, good, and bad. When we are confronted by choices, options, or moral dilemmas, the decisions we make will indicate what morals we hold."

The virtual seminar, which was moderated by Neeraj Bajpai, journalist, India had participations of over 40 countries and eminent philosophers and scholars took part in

Dr. Michael Geary, USA, Founder – Cranmore Academy LLP who joined from Florida, US highlighted the significance of the proposed day and said without morality, everything is at stake. He laced his arguments with quotes from internationally acclaimed epic Mahabharata. He recalled the last days of Bhishma Pitamaha, who despite lying on a bed made of arrows at the Kurushetra was giving lessons of morality and Dharma to his surviving clan members.

According to Mr. Geary, the renowned archer made a profound statement that" He who nurtures morality will be sustained by morality. He strongly advocated the practice of non-violence to bring the purity of mind and soul. He says anyone who harbors anger, resentment, etc. does it so at his or her own peril as all these negative thoughts generate clutter in the mind and disturb mental peace.

He made a pertinent philosophical point that principles of morality exist in-universe as energetic particles if we have consciousness for these principles, they sustain us if we neglect them, we do that at our own peril. He said Indian sages followed all these traditions.

Mr. Geary's observations were followed by Dr. BV Nemi Swami, UK, Founder – Wisdom Alliance, he said that unless inner consciousness is not pure, it would impact adversely both body and mind. He said the moral and ethical values create a pure ecosystem and people perform better for the common cause of the community and humanity as a whole.

He strongly supported the idea of the Moral day and said such concepts were required as the standards in the society are falling at a rapid pace and nations are waging war against each other in various formats like stealing data or by resorting to cyber-attacks on systems.

He said the world needs a common purpose to increase the wellbeing of everybody. He said the body, mind and soul should work in complete harmony. It is the duty of the leaders to create good framework work so that best values can be practices bereft of any bias on the basis caste, creed religion, or color of skin.

He observed that wellbeing is the birthright of every individual.

Dr. Sergey Dvoryanov, Russia, President – International Diplomatic Club said the morality and spirituality are inseparable. He said the world's moral day would create positive vibes and coming generations will continue to cherish social and moral values. Carrying forward its agenda of the World Morale Day” On September every year to promote human values, The WHD organized a webinar to highlight growing light of asylum seekers and dangers fraught migration.

Four women leaders, sharing their ideas and thoughts in building bridges of hope to support and give a strong voice to the voiceless and to bridge happiness to families especially in the immigration sector embarked on their discussions on immigration issues with a famous quote that the opposite of love is not hated but indifference.

A live wire moderator Dr. Anandhi Narasimhan who articulated the world wide concerns about the asylum seekers recalled a famous Mexican philosopher’s crisp advice to the indifferent societies –Recognize Yourself in He or She who is like You or Me”.

She is also an asylum evaluator for Physicians for Human Rights and involved in research looking into using digital therapeutics and artificial intelligence to improve early detection and interventions. She advocated the need for international efforts to address woes of immigrants. The seminar theme was “The Effect of Immigration -Policies of Children”.

With this couple of soul searching quotes, they dissected upon the issue and strongly batted for a view that the international community must exert pressure on the United States to review its immigration policies via a prism of humanity and concerns as the

They aired their concerns over the growing woes of migrants who are subjected to all sorts of hardships at borders because of strict immigration regimes implementation with zero tolerance. Their plight is compounded in their own cities where crime, rape, looting violence, bombarding and all sorts of night marsh happenings are the order of the day.

Amy Cohen said the increase in migration of children to borders is the consequence of terrible circumstances in their home countries: circumstances which must be addressed in those countries of origin.

But until they are, can we not agree that children running for their lives deserve our care and a chance to heal and grow? That policies which seek to harm these children – that are entirely contrary to all that we know about what is in their best interest – are simply not who we are or should be?

That these policies demean us all and reduce our standing in the world? Surely as doctors and legislators, as human beings, we must be able to come together on this.

Amy Cohen, a child and family psychiatrist who has devoted most of my career to addressing the psychological needs of vulnerable and traumatized children. Over the past year, I have mostly worked with newly migrated children and families at the border, with parents separated from their children at Port Isabel, and as a mental health and, sometimes, medical consultant to *Flores* Settlement Agreement counsel.

In her last capacity, she has visited Office of Refugee Resettlement (ORR) facilities, interviewed many children, poured over thousands of pages of records, and worked with the Special Master tasked by the *Flores* court judge to have independent oversight of children in custody. She had got a rare look inside an otherwise very opaque system of detention which now holds about 14,000 migrant children.

Informatively. Today, more people than ever live in a country other than the one in which they were born. In 2019, the number of migrants globally reached an estimated **272 million**, 51 million more than in 2010.

International migrants comprise 3.5 percent of the global population. Compared to 2.8 percent in 2000 and 2.3 percent in 1980, the proportion of international migrants in the world population has also risen.

While many individuals migrate out of choice, many others migrate out of necessity. The number of globally forcibly displaced people topped 70 million for the first time in UNHCR's almost 70 year history at the end of 2018. This number includes almost 26 million refugees, 3.5 million asylum seekers, and over 41 million internally displaced persons.

Experts aired their reservations on the US government's policies and said the federal government has continued to separate migrant children from their parents in the US

Mostly asylum seekers – families fleeing dangerous neighborhoods or life-threatening poverty and hoping to find sanctuary here in the U.S. Whether they receive that help is a matter for the immigration courts, but in the meantime, the government should not be treating them as criminals, and it certainly should not be abusing children psychologically by spiriting them away without a damned good and well-justified reason to do so.

Colleen A. Kraft, Professor of Pediatrics at the Keck School of the Medicine/University of Southern California and Children's Hospital Los Angeles expressed her anguish over the plight of immigrants and said on borders, expert doctors are not there to deal with children in camps and only medical staff are there. She said it was painful that science was being pushed aside to deal with situations and the development during the raging pandemic speak volumes of such a pathetic thought process.

She is the 2018 Past President of the American Academy of Pediatrics. Her work includes the integration of behavioral health into primary care practice. Dr. Kraft received her undergraduate degree at Virginia Tech and her M.D. from Virginia Commonwealth University, and her MBA from the University of Cincinnati. She completed her residency in Pediatrics at Virginia Commonwealth University.

As President of the American Academy of Pediatrics in 2018, Dr. Kraft is best known for her advocacy for the humane treatment of migrant children at the US-Mexico border.

Her explanation to the public regarding the harm to young children during the "Zero Tolerance" policy that included the separation of children from parents at the border help to mobilize advocates across the political spectrum to end this policy. She continues to advocate for basic child rights for children throughout the world.

Casey Revkin is a financial expert, mother, and dedicated supporter of migrant children. She served as California Director of Immigrant Families Together, a national rapid-response fund dedicated to reuniting immigrant families separated at the U.S./Mexico border was of the view that the problem must be addressed on human values parameters

It adds, "After nine hours of the Barcelona attack, five men thought to be members of the same terrorist cell drove into pedestrians in nearby **Cambrils**, killing one woman and injuring six others. All five of those attackers were shot and killed by police.

The night before the Barcelona attack, an explosion occurred in a house in the Spanish town of **Alcanar**, destroying the building and killing two members of the terrorist cell, including the 40-year-old **imam** thought to be the mastermind.^[8] The home had more than 120 gas canisters inside which police believe the cell was attempting to make into one large bomb (or three smaller bombs to be placed in three vans which they had rented) but which they accidentally detonated"

The UK is entering a "period of particular concern" as the number of coronavirus cases were increasing across the country, Housing Secretary Robert Jenrick said on Tuesday.

They are also more likely to live in poverty and to suffer higher rates of violence, neglect, and abuse.

“The pandemic is intensifying these inequalities – and producing new threats,” he revealed.

Mr. Guterres said people with disabilities are among the hardest hit. They face a lack of accessible public health information and significant barriers to implementing basic hygiene measures, as well as inaccessible health facilities.

“If they contract COVID-19, many are more likely to develop severe health conditions, which may result in death”, he added.

‘Astonishing’ care home death rates

“The share of COVID-19 related deaths in care homes – where older people with disabilities are overrepresented – ranges from 19 percent to an astonishing 72 percent”.

Additionally, in some countries, healthcare rationing decisions are based on discriminatory criteria, such as age or assumptions about quality or value of life, based on disability: something which must not be allowed to continue.

“We must guarantee the equal rights of people with disabilities to access healthcare and lifesaving procedures during the pandemic”, he said.

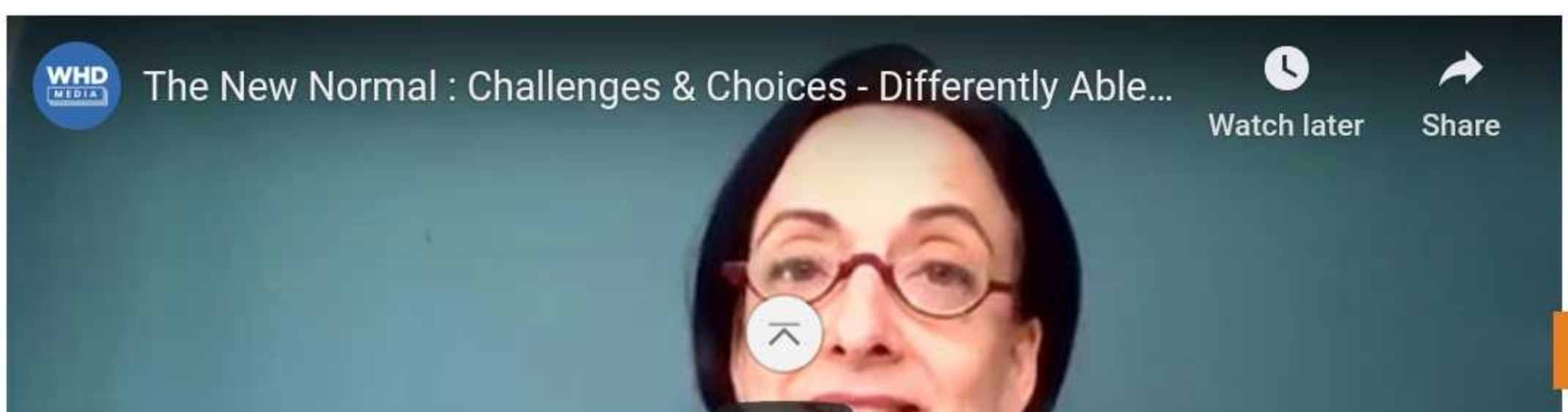

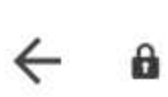

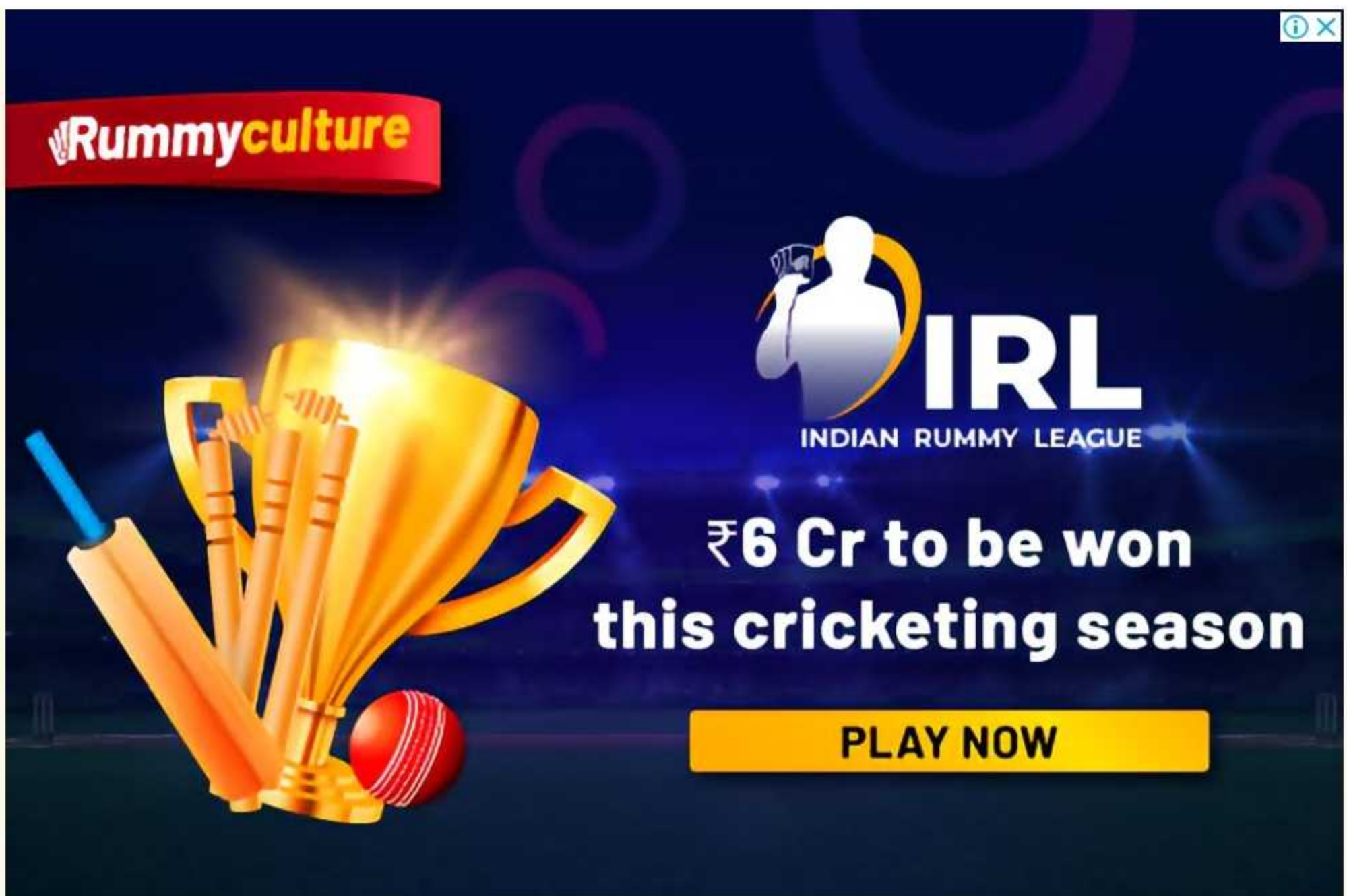

Unidentified militant groups frequently fire mortar rounds on Iraqi military bases housing US-led coalition forces as well as the American embassy in Baghdad's heavily fortified Green Zone, where the main Iraqi government offices and some foreign embassies are located. The UK is part of a US-led international coalition tasked with helping the Iraqi security forces in the fight against the Islamic State militants by carrying out airstrikes against their positions in Iraq and Syria as well as providing military equipment and training for Iraqi forces.

For this reason and the fact that surprisingly Vincent had resided right here in Isleworth during his career, it was only fitting to have Vincent's infamous self-portrait on the streets of Hounslow East, a neighbour to Isleworth.

The neighbours are so happy and 4 out of 10 people walking from the road click a selfie in front of our painting. That was the whole idea to make such painting to make Hounslow ill More creative and artistic.

I have 4 Guinness world records in art my first record was in 2003 in Vancouver for worlds largest finger painting then I break my own record in 2007 and in 2013 I have created worlds largest foot print painting and last one was in 2017 worlds largest painting made by mouth. All these records are made for charity project to support local charities.

The art studio gallery is my long time dream to help local community to be more creative and involved in art.

Q: Give us more information about your art gallery?

A: We created this unique place in Hounslow and snow officially open for local communities from Sunday 27th September.

We have lots to share and we are very excited to let local community know about us.

Q: What are your future plans?

A: The future plan is to start online art lessons free for all and then one to one art classes at our studio. In last few months we have successfully train more than 200 participants all age to develop their art abilities.

We are very grateful for the support we have received so far from the locals in Hounslow East. The locals as well as the general public have shown a very positive response. Like us, they too felt that Hounslow needed some form of art and creativity. This one and only mural in the area really added it's character.

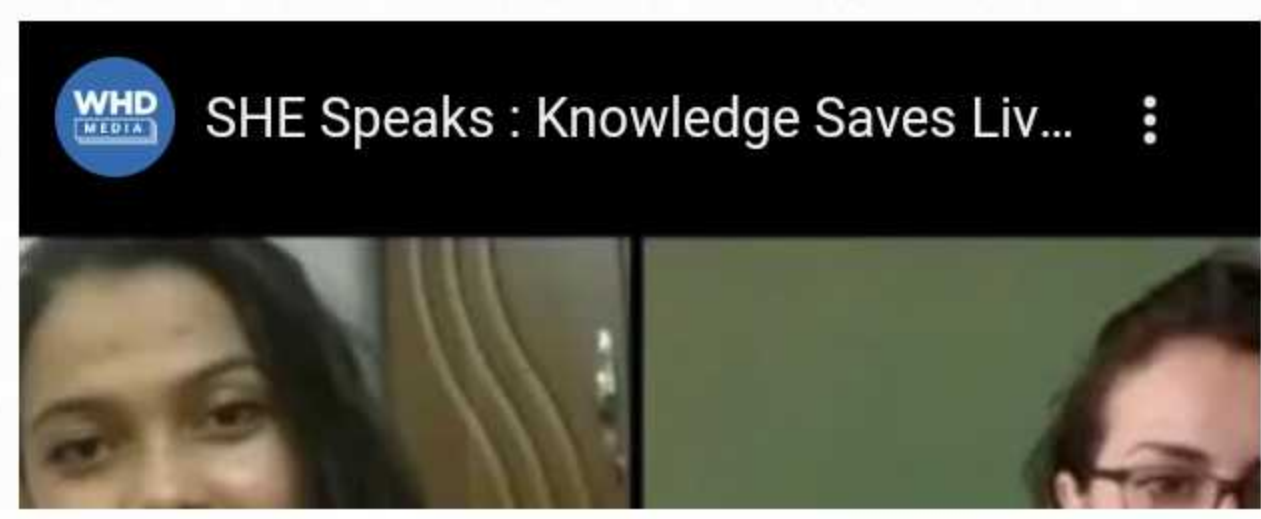

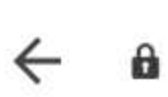

The World Humanitarian Drive (WHD) has strongly condemned a knife attack inside a French church in the southern French city of Nice, which reportedly left three worshippers dead and described it as a barbaric savage cowardly, vile, and shameful act.

The WHD's founder President Dr. Abdul Basit Syed, in a statement, has called for tolerance, acceptance, and the protection of life, human dignity human worth, and the sanctity of life.

He also deplored the attempted act to harm an injure people in the Montfavet district in Avignon.

" It must be made abundantly clear that these criminal individuals neither represent 1.7 billion Muslims across the world nor adhere to the basic principles of Islam or any faith", he said.

The incident has been condemned in a bay way across the world.

The UN **Secretary-General** on Thursday had strongly condemned the attack. In a **statement** released by his Spokesperson, António Guterres extended his condolences to the families of the victims, and reaffirmed "the solidarity of the United Nations with the people and the Government of France."

The UN statement had said:A lone attacker armed with a knife entered the Notre Dame Basilica in the city center at around 9 am, according to news reports. A man and a woman died at the scene, while another woman died from her injuries. The attacker was injured after being shot by police and taken to hospital.

French authorities are treating it as a terrorist incident.

The deadly attack in Nice, was not the only violent incident to take place on Thursday, in the wake of a strong reaction in France, led by President Macron, to the beheading of a teacher near Paris nearly two weeks ago.

That attack was reportedly carried out in response to the re-publication of satirical caricatures of the Prophet Muhammed, in the Charlie Hebdo magazine.

only attack in Nice, was not the only violent incident to take place on Thursday, in the wake of a strong reaction in France, led by President Macron, to the beheading of a teacher near Paris nearly two weeks ago.

That attack was reportedly carried out in response to the re-publication of satirical caricatures of the Prophet Muhammed, in the Charlie Hebdo magazine.

A man was shot dead on Thursday near the southern French city of Avignon, after reportedly threatening police with a handgun, and according to news reports, a guard outside the French consulate in Jeddah, Saudi Arabia, was attacked and wounded. The suspect was detained.

Following the killings in Nice, French police have launched a murder inquiry, with President Macron denouncing it as an "Islamist terrorist attack", and the national security alert system has been raised to its highest level.

In the wake of the killing of school teacher Samuel Paty, and President Macron's defence of the publication of the cartoons, there have been protests in some Muslim nations at what is being perceived as an anti-Muslim backlash and calls for a boycott of French goods, including from Turkish President, Recep Tayyip Erdogan.

'Intolerable and utterly unjustifiable' attacks, but mutual tolerance needed

In a **statement** issued in response to the killings in Nice, the senior UN official who oversees the protection of religious sites and advocates for religious tolerance, **Miguel Aïngel Moratinos**, strongly condemned the "barbaric attack", stressing that any attacks targeting civilians, including worshippers, were "intolerable and utterly unjustifiable, whenever, wherever and by whomsoever committed."

But the High-Representative for the UN Alliance of Civilizations (**UNAOC**), also noted that such "outrageous crimes should not dissuade us from working together to promote mutual respect and peace globally, as one humanity."

In an **earlier statement** released on Wednesday, he said that he was following the fallout from "growing tensions and instances of intolerance" triggered by the publication of the satirical caricatures of the Prophet Muhammed, with "deep concern".

Mr. Moratinos noted that “the freedom of religion or belief and the freedom of expression are interdependent, interrelated and mutually re-enforcing rights rooted in the articles 18 and 19 of the **Universal Declaration of Human Rights** (UDHR), noting that upholding and protecting these fundamental rights is the primary responsibility of Member States.
